

Which SenSource Patron Counter is Right for Your Library and Your Budget?

#SSPCWTB06XL

Smaller libraries with less traffic and smaller budgets should consider this battery-powered, photoelectric, non-directional people counter.

- Includes EVERYTHING you need to start tracking patrons today!
- Registers one count when IR beam between transmitter and receiver is broken by a patron walking through the door
- Six-digit numeric LCD display
- Displays one total for all in and out traffic
- You simply divide the number by two to get the number of patrons per day (or week) and reset it
- Monitors doorway openings from 18 inches to 35 feet wide
- Battery-powered backup so counts are not lost if power is lost
- Available in light grey or black

Smaller libraries with less traffic, more entries/exits (or branches) and larger budgets should consider this battery-powered, photoelectric, non-directional people counter kit which includes the counter described above plus a sensor server to collect and store data. You will need one Sensor Server for each facility.

- Server can monitor up to 100 doorways when used with the non-directional counter in this system
- Data Logger creates time stamped records of count values
- Data can be exported to SQL, XML, Excel and TEXT or viewed from within the software when you add Server Manager Software (sold separately)
- Server Manager Software (sold separately) also allows you to create reports that include traffic and occupancy data for a specified time frame
- Available in light grey or black

Larger libraries with heavy traffic, more entries/exits (or branches) and larger budgets should consider our TOP-OF-THE-LINE Overhead Thermal Imaging Patron Counter System. You will need one Sensor Server for each facility. If your Sensor Server is located very far from your Patron Counter(s), you may need to purchase a Repeater to collect and retransmit the wireless signal to the Sensor Server. - Counts multiple patrons entering and exiting at the same time
- Distinguishes between entry and exit counts
- Functions by identifying body heat as infra-red radiation

- Operates without interference from ambient lighting
- Kit includes Overhead Patron Counter, 900 MHz transmitter and Sensor Server
- Allows you to define specific counting areas
- System expands easily with the addition of extra sensors (counter #SSPCTHI60 sold separately)
- Operates without interference from ambient light

Directional Counter/Transmitter Benefits:

- Enables sensor to wirelessly transmit data to Sensor Server

If your library purchases Kit #SSPCWTB06XLK, #SSPCTHI60WK or the Sensor Server separately, you must buy a Server Manager Software License. The Server Manager Software programs, controls and queries the Service Manager. The Software also offers additional benefits and options that include exporting data for use in other business management software programs and generating reports. (There is no need for privacy concerns. Your network cannot be accessed wirelessly through the Sensor Server since wireless communication is only used for data exchange between the Sensors (counters) and the Sensor Server.)

Server Manager Software Benefits:

- Allows you to use traffic counts to staff more efficiently

- Contains battery backed RAM so data is not lost with power outages
